



Differentiation Protocol

IRES-GFP Stable LUHMES Cell Line

Culture conditions recommended for the differentiation of IRES-GFP Stable LUHMES cells:

Advanced DMEM/F12 (Gibco), + 1X N2 supplement + 2mM L-glutamine ([G275](#)) + 1mM dbcAMP + 1 μ g/ml tetracycline, and + 2 ng/ml Recombinant Human GDNF ([Z101055](#)).

To differentiate the cells into neurons, change the medium to differentiation medium after the cells have grown to a density of 40-50%. Allow the cells to grow in differentiation medium for 4-6 days before testing for neuron specific markers.
